

**LEGAL NOTICE  
INLAND WETLANDS - ENVIRONMENT  
COMMISSION OF THE TOWN OF EAST HARTFORD**

At the March 22, 2016 meeting of the Inland Wetlands - Environment Commission of the Town of East Hartford, the Commission voted to take the following actions:

- A. Approved File #2016-002, Application of the Town of East Hartford to conduct a regulated activity in the Inland Wetlands and Upland Review areas in conjunction with a project to use an on-site well to provide water for irrigation at the East Hartford Golf Course at 130 Long Hill Street.
- B. Approved File #2016-003, Application of General Equities, Inc. to conduct a regulated activity in the Upland Review area in conjunction with construction activities associated with renovation of a gas station including construction of a new canopy, alteration of parking area, underground fuel storage tanks, storm drainage system and landscaping at 1259 Burnside Ave.
- C. Tabled File #2016-005, Application of the Goodwin College to conduct a regulated activity in an Inland Wetlands area in conjunction with a project to construct 3,200 LF of recreational walking trail with signage and benches within the South Meadows on land owned by Goodwin College.
- D. Tabled File #2016-006, Application for permit modification and extension of Permit # 2014-019, Pratt & Whitney Division of United Technologies to conduct a regulated activity in the inland wetlands and inland wetlands upland review area to perform remedial soil excavation and off-site disposal at 1 Pent Road, East Hartford (aka 125 High Street).
